

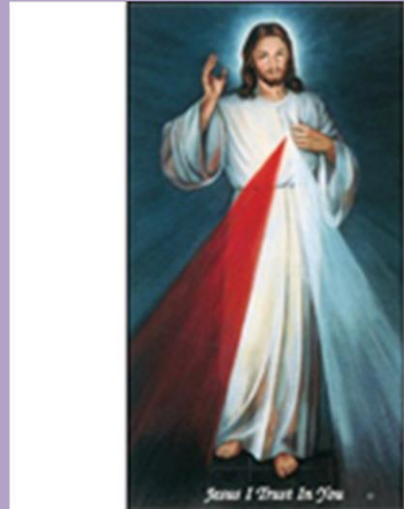

RCIA – the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults
