“La Arquidiócesis de Oklahoma City ha retirado las facultades sacerdotales al P. John Mejía-Muñoz y ha sido removido del ministerio público. Esto significa que no está autorizado a realizar ningún ministerio público, incluyendo la celebración de misas y la administración de otros sacramentos. Esta decisión se ha tomado después de mucha consideración y debido a situaciones relacionadas con el mal manejo de recursos económicos, siempre buscando el bien del P. Mejía y de la gente de la Arquidiócesis”.

"Due to ongoing issues involving a lack of financial accountability and failure to comply with archdiocesan financial policies, it has been determined that Father John Mejia-Munoz will be released of his priestly faculties in the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City, and he will be removed from public ministry. This means he will not be able to conduct any public ministry, including celebrating the Mass or administering other sacraments. These steps are being taken after much consideration for the good of Father Mejia and, most importantly, for the good of the people of the archdiocese. The bishop of the Diocese of Quibdo, Columbia, where he is incardinated, is being informed of this action."
